

SPECIAL INFORMATION FOR 2020 CAMP

1. All Families are required to practice 6ft distancing during drop off/pick up with persons outside of immediate family members.
2. At Check In, Parent/Guardian and Camper must stop by the Camp Medical Team Table, with their Intake Form to be temperature tested, form will be signed by the Medical Team, then Parent/Guardian will proceed to the Registration Office.
3. At Check In, only one Parent/Guardian, allowed to enter Registration Office. Camper will stay outside and pick up t-shirt. Parent must turn in ALL medications and Camper Cell Phone at Registration Office. **NO CELL PHONES OR ELECTRONICS ALLOWED IN CABIN.**
4. **NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINKS IN THE KITCHEN, TRADING POST, OR CABINS.** (If there is a medical need for outside food or drinks, please contact Jan Branch at (469) 951-1758)
5. Mail will be held for 24 hours before given to campers or staff. Please do not send your camper edible items.
6. **NO PARENTS ALLOWED IN CABINS OR PAST THE DESIGNATED SIGNS.** (Ball Field)
7. If you wish your camper to wear a mask, please send with them.
8. If a Camper shows symptoms of illness and meet the criteria of COVID-19, that Camper will be immediately removed from the group and moved to the designated Isolation Cabin.
9. The Camp Medical Team will evaluate and contact Parents/Guardians.
10. If Camper has symptoms and a fever of 100.4 or higher, camper will be quarantined and parents/guardians will be notified to **PROMPTLY** pick up camper.
11. **No Parent/Guardian or Visitors ALLOWED beyond the Ball Field at any time.**
12. **No Parent/Guardian or Visitors ALLOWED during Friday Night Council Ring**
13. If you have a Camper who will be a War Bonnet recipient this year, please contact Jan Branch (469) 951-1758.
14. If Parent/Guardian needs to pick up Camper before Saturday Morning, they must stop at House and someone will bring Camper to the house.
15. At Pick Up, Parents/Guardians will drive around Ball Field to designated area with your Campers name and pick up Camper and luggage. No Parents/Guardians or Visitors allowed past the Ball Field.
16. Once Campers are dismissed to come to the Ball Field, they and their parents are not permitted to go back to the cabins, lake, trading post, Hogan, craft lodge, etc.
