Camper's Suitcase should include:

- Play clothes for 6 days
- Athletic shoes, sandals for the water only
- Modest Swim Suite and beach towel
- Bedding, pillow, towel, wash cloth, toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, personal items
- Laundry Bag or extra pillow slip
- Bible
- Flashlight, insect repellent, sun screen
- Fishing pole, ball glove, or Frisbee, if desired

These items are strictly PROHIBITED!:

- Matches or lighters
- Cigarettes or illegal drugs
- Radios, CD, or Ipods, or computers
- TV's of any size
- Weapons of any sort (guns, knives, scissors, etc)
- Cellular or digital phones
- Video or any electronic games
- Snack food or drinks (except water) are not allowed in the cabins
- **Do not mail or send snacks, drinks, or silly string to campers, there will not be space available.**
- No clothing which exhibits alcohol, drugs, tobacco products, satanic symbols, inappropriate language, or other offensive displays
